## **NSS Consolidated Brief Report**

## (1st December 2022 to 15th March 2023)

The National Service Scheme NSS Unit of the College has organized following activities from 1<sup>st</sup> December 2022 to 15<sup>th</sup> March 2023.

## 1) 02/12/2022: Street Play on Cyber Security in collaboration with Mumbai Police

Crime Branch- Cyber Cell, Mumbai Police organized Street Play on the theme of Cyber Security for the benefit of students. NSS volunteers along with other college students attended the programme. An awareness about various types of cybercrimes like email frauds, social media frauds, banking frauds, ransomware attacks, cyber espionage, identity theft, clickjacking, spyware, etc. and safety measures to avoid them were explained through the Street Play. The Street paly was performed in various classrooms and also in the college campus outside the canteen.









## 2) 07/12/2022: Skin Donation Awareness Programme- Resource Person- Ms. Sonal Somaiya

The programme was organized in Geeta Mandir Hall of Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan from 9.00 am to 11.30 am, to create an awareness about Organ Donation with special focus on Skin Donation. ## 7) 21/01/2023: Intercollegiate event IGNEEL


