NEW ACADEMIC PROGRAMS AND FACILITIES

The college has expanded its infrastructure to enhance learning opportunities for students. A new B.Sc.(I.T.) program has been introduced, supported by a state-of-the-art computer lab located on the second floor. In addition, a postgraduate program, M.Com. in Accountancy, has been added to cater to advanced studies in Commerce. A new BMS (Bachelor of Management Studies) unit has been launched to meet the growing demand for management education. These additions aim to provide diverse and quality education to students across various disciplines.

RESULT ANALYSIS

The result analysis for the academic year 2023-2024 highlights the overall performance of students across the Third-year undergraduate programs. The TYBA (Bachelor of Arts) class achieved a pass percentage of 65.52%, while the TYBCOM (Bachelor of Commerce) class secured a slightly higher performance with 67.12%. In contrast, the TYBSC (Bachelor of Science) class recorded a relatively lower pass percentage at 46.67%. On the other hand, specialized programs demonstrated remarkable outcomes, with TYBAF (Bachelor of Accounting and Finance) achieving an impressive 85.49% and TYBMS (Bachelor of Management Studies) following closely with 84%. These results reflect admirable achievements in professional courses while indicating areas for improvement in certain core programs.


