



Figure 1: Our Stakeholders


1. Learning value (in terms of skills, concepts, knowledge, analytical abilities, or broadening perspectives)

Learning value response/feedback is good (40%) and very good (30%). Other quantitative and qualitative measures are almost negligible.


Similarly below chart shows applicability/relevance to real life situations is also Good (40%) .



2. Applicability/relevance to real life situations




<u>3.Depth the courser content</u> Depth of courses content is good (but response is below 40 %). But in NEP 2024-25 batch we are much focused in



course content.


4. Extent of coverage of course

Course covered during academic year is good. The response is above 45 % and beneath to 50%.




5.Extent of effort required by students

Extent of effort required by students shows majorly good (50% which quite satisfactory because 50% work ,task almost use to get completed in the classroom and in laboratories by faculty members .i




6. Relevance/learning value of project/report
